University of Colorado **Academy of Medical Educators**' <u>Teaching Scholars Program</u>: 18-month program for junior faculty, one spot per 20-person cohort reserved for a fellow whose fellowship is in med ed or clinical ed (very competitive)

Association of American Medical Colleges' Medical Education Research Certificate program: six three-hour workshops about conducting and interpreting med ed research

Teaching & Mentorship Opportunities

- 1. Work with trainees on inpatient teams on floors and ICU
- 2. Attend rounds with primary team and consultants when possible
- 3. Discuss consults with residents over phone and in workrooms
- 4. Arrange chalk talks with resident teams in afternoons
- 5. Attend resident morning report
- 6. Residents' academic half-day each subspecialty has at least 1 per year with residents - opportunity for faculty & fellows to teach residents subspecialty-specific information
- 7. Serve as a mentor for a medical student's Mentored Scholarly Activity
- 8. Volunteer to teach medical and PA students within various venues (didactics, problem-based learning sessions)
- 9. Outreach education for primary care providers: virtual and live
