The Care Collaborative offers two innovative programs at the University of Colorado Anschutz School of Medicine: ECHO Colorado (Extension for Community Health Outcomes) and eConsults (electronic consultations). Through these programs, primary care providers across the state can partner with colleagues at the Anschutz Medical Campus, creating a virtual, patient-centered medical community that ultimately improves access to care for Coloradans.

Making expertise accessible throughout the healthcare system creates sustainable solutions that support better outcomes for patients and providers, to help Coloradans live healthier lives.

ECHOs are interactive learning experiences that promote peer-to-peer engagement while disseminating curated medical knowledge that addresses today's health challenges. Providers share knowledge and experiences during ECHO sessions, creating a virtual community that leads to a stronger healthcare network.

eConsults facilitate asynchronous communication between Colorado primary care providers and specialists at CU Anschutz. eConsults help healthcare practitioners and their patients by making it easier and more affordable, especially for people living in rural areas, to get the care they need, when they need it.



Colorado Reach

The Care Collaborative's programs reach all 64 Colorado counties. More than 6,600 healthcare professionals have participated in an ECHO, and over 2,100 providers have submitted an eConsult. Twenty one percent of ECHO Colorado participants are from rural or frontier counties.

Medicaid, FQHCs and Rural Colorado

In order to impact health equity across the state, The Care Collaborative's efforts focus on serving Medicaid, rural and Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) patients and providers in Colorado. Medicaid is a vital partner in this work. Since 2021, the eConsults program has extended its reach to 52 community-based clinics through an external platform, including 47 FQHCs (Salud, Peak Vista, Valley-Wide, High Plains and STRIDE) and five clinics at MidValley and Rio Grande. To date, 298 FQHC providers have submitted over 2,700 eConsults.
