We are conducting a research study to compare the effectiveness of a Dexcom G7 CGM with Routine Care (RC) in managing glucose levels in people with type 2 diabetes currently not using insulin.

You May Qualify If....

- You are at least 18 years old.
- You do not use insulin.
- Have been diagnosed with type 2 diabetes for at least 6 months.
- Have an HbA1c level of 7.5% or higher.
- Have not used CGM in the last 6 months.
- Have been on the same diabetes medications and doses for the last month.

What is Asked of You....

- You will be required to attend six in-person clinic visits over 12 months with our study team.
- You will wear a Dexcom G7 CGM.
- You will be provided with Dexcom CGM supplies.
- You will be compensated for your time and participation.
