HIGHLIGHTS Elizabeth Thomas, M.D.

Dr. Thomas is an Assistant Professor in the Division of Endocrinology, Metabolism and Diabetes, with clinical and research interests in obesity and weight management. She is originally from Denver and received her undergraduate degree in Biology from the University of Michigan and MD



degree from the University of Colorado. She completed Internal Medicine residency at the University of North Carolina and then returned home to complete her Endocrinology fellowship here at the University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus. During her research fellowship she worked with Dr. Marc Cornier in the area of appetite and body weight regulation, which led her to study meal patterns and how they affect appetite, body weight, and energy balance. As emerging evidence has highlighted the importance of timing of energy intake on weight regulation and the metabolic benefits of fasting, she became interested in time restricted eating (TRE). Leading a team of scientists, she recently completed a pilot trial of TRE for weight loss in adults with overweight and obesity, which laid the groundwork for a larger randomized trial designed to investigate the effects of early vs. late TRE, as compared to daily caloric restriction, on body weight, cardiometabolic outcomes, physical activity, and sleep. She recently received an 11th percentile score on an R01 award to support this trial and is hoping to receive official notification of funding soon! In addition to establishing her research program, she has clinical responsibilities in both general endocrinology and weight management at the VA Medical Center, and she serves as the Associate Program Director for the endocrinology fellowship program.
