## **Health Care**

#### \*In-network Primary Care Physician



<u>Establish your care with a PCP now</u> so you have your in-network PCP connection for treatment such as routine/preventive care, minor illness or injury, and coordination of your health care.

Patients who have established care with a PCP have <u>improved access to</u> <u>appointment times and options to communicate with your PCP</u> via phone, email or online when you get sick or have a health care concern.

In-network office visit copay - \$20

### \*In-network Urgent Care and ER Alternatives



Urgent care and alternatives to the ER are options for when you have a sudden illness, such as flu, or minor injuries or abrasions that need to be addressed more immediately.

Urgent care and ER alternatives generally have <u>extended evening and weekend</u> <u>hours</u> and are on a walk-in basis (no appointment necessary).

Use the emergency room in a true emergency. Emergency room level care provides critical, life-saving services for those facing true health emergencies. It's expensive and should not be used for your convenience. If you have a life threatening situation or medical emergency, go to the nearest emergency room or call 911.
