

## Scheduling Immunization Screening and Mask Fit Appointments for Residents and Fellows NEW to CU GME

- The Immunization Screening and Mask Fit Testing are **MANDATORY and must be completed within one week of training start date.**
- Each resident or fellow in your program who is **NEW to CU GME** must have an appointment for the screening and mask fit and keep the scheduled appointment time. Residents and fellows that are **transferring within CU GME programs**, even when they are new to your training program, **do not** participate in the screenings.
- Appointment should be scheduled as close as possible to actual start dates using the dates when PROHealth will be at Anschutz.
- **For Interns Starting June 23rd:** Alyssa Maxfeldt ([Alyssa.Maxfeldt@cuanschutz.edu](mailto:Alyssa.Maxfeldt@cuanschutz.edu)) will schedule Immunization Screening and Mask Fit Appointments for all Interns starting training on June 23<sup>rd</sup> and provide schedule information to the program coordinator.
- **For Residents and Fellows PGY 2s and above:** Program coordinator will schedule Residents and Fellows.

### To Schedule:

- Contact **PROHealth** (Program for Resident Occupational Health) **now** via email at [PROHealth@dhha.org](mailto:PROHealth@dhha.org) to schedule appointments for your residents and fellows.
- In your email request, please include:
  - Date of requested appointment(s). (PROHealth will assign specific appointment times.)
  - Names, PGY levels and start dates of the residents or fellows for whom you are scheduling.
    - *If you do not know names, request the number of appointments your program will need. As soon as you know the names of your new residents or fellows, notify PROHealth. This allows PROHealth to be prepared for each individual appointment.*
- PROHealth will respond with a confirmation email, including appointment dates and times for your residents and fellows.
- Screenings are *by appointment only*. Walk-ins will not be accepted.

### On-Campus IZ Screening Dates:

PROHealth will be on the Anschutz Medical Campus to provide screenings and mask fits for residents/fellows with scheduled appointments on:

*\*Residents NEW to CU GME must attend the GME Institutional Orientation on 7/1/2021 from 10am -2pm and cannot be scheduled for screenings during that time. Fellows NEW to CU GME do not attend the GME Institutional Orientation and may be scheduled for screenings on 7/1/2021.*

## **Special COVID-19 Procedures and Requirements for your residents and fellows**

Due to continued restrictions for personnel on campus, all residents and fellows and program coordinators attending IZ screening appointments must adhere to following guidelines:

- Please keep in mind the time and location of the on-campus Immunization Screenings for your incoming residents and fellows:
  - Screenings will be held in the **Strauss Health Sciences Library, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor Reading Room**
- PROHealth is scheduling appointments on these days so that there are 10 appointments in each 30 minute block.
- If you are bringing your residents to the screening site, do not have more than 10 people in your group. If you escort your residents to these appointments, you must wait outside the library.
- Adhere to all safety and social distancing guidelines (face masks, 6 ft. distancing) if ushering residents to their appointments.
- Please make sure that you and your residents are adhering to special COVID-19 requirements for being on the Anschutz Campus. (SkillSoft Training and Completion of Health Questionnaire on date of appointment).
- **You must have completed the required, one-time Skillsoft training**, “CU: COVID-19 Return to Campus - CU Anschutz (2021 update)” through [the My.CU portal](#) in order to be admitted to campus.
- **You must be wearing your CU Anschutz badge and a [face mask](#)** while on campus. Your badge is needed to gain access to the library building. If you have not received your badge, please talk to the attendant at the door who can contact the GME representative at the immunization screenings to assist you.
- **You must also have successfully completed the [daily health questionnaire](#)**, and have a confirmation email ready to show, *before* arriving at a designated campus check-in point.
- **BE ON TIME** if bringing your resident to their appointments. Allow yourself extra time to get through on-campus screening checkpoints and still arrive appointment on time.
