Denver Health Resident Loop Closure Opportunities

BACKGROUND

The academic year 2023-2024 DH and CU ACGME resident/fellow patient safety and quality incentive program requires each resident/fellow attend at least two loop closure events between July 2023 and April 2024.

WHAT ARE LOOP CLOSURES?

Loop closure events are meant to be structured reviews of one or more STARS (patient safety) reports submitted by your program, department, or service line to determine root causes and consider potential solutions. See the Loop Closure Meeting <u>guide here</u>.

HOW ARE LOOP CLOSURES RECORDED?

Loop closures must be <u>reported here</u> by residents and fellows to get credit for this portion of the resident/fellow patient safety and quality incentive program metric.

WHERE ARE THE MEETINGS?

Residents and fellows can attend loop closure meetings from any specialty; it does not have to be one hosted by your program. Loop closure meetings could be morning huddles, existing outcomes or case conferences, etc. They do not need to be newly established meetings just for addressing patient safety (STARS) reports. Regular discussions in settings that work best for a particular team are encouraged. It is also encouraged that programs share schedules with other departments/programs to give residents and fellows opportunities for attending discussions across specialties.
