Denver Health SI System Transition to STARS

WHO: Residents and fellows participating in the GME Quality and Safety Incentive Program.

WHAT: Your Denver Health metric requires submission of Safety Intelligence (SI) reports. **The SI system is transitioning to a new platform called STARS**.

WHEN: Effective January 31, 2023.

WHY: STARS offers beneficial data capabilities and transparency. As a reporter, you will be able to log back into incidents to view their status.

What do I need to do?

- Continue incident reporting just as you do now but starting January 31 you will click on the STARS icon instead of the SI icon, located on all Denver Health desktop computers.
- Just as you do now, indicate you are a resident/fellow and select your residency/fellowship program in order to receive credit for your incident submission. Reporting can still be anonymous (no name required).
- Optional: Denver Health is offering 14 training sessions on the new STARS platform. To participate, email Michelle.Reitz@dhha.org.
