## Reporting Adverse Events at Children's Hospital Colorado

Residents and Fellows training at Children's Colorado should be aware of the types of vulnerabilities and range of reportable patient safety events.

- Incidents - Something that occurred that should not have, or something that did not occur that should have.
- Events - Incidents that reach a patient
- Near Misses - Potential to impact patients, operations or team members (risks to safety)

Residents, fellows, should know that it is their responsibility to report patient safety events into the clinical site's central reporting system.

## Children's Quality Safety Reporting System (QSRS)

Quality and Safety Reporting System (QSRS) is a voluntary reporting system for Team Members to report any event that is not expected as part of the routine care of the patient or the day-to-day operation of the hospital. All CHCO team members have access to the QSRS system through My Children's Colorado SharePoint app or through EPIC. **Use this QR code to access the Children's QSRS homepage. You will need to log into the CHCO network.**



Once you have accessed the QSRS homepage, click on the link shown below to access the QSRS reporting tool and report an incident.

## QSRS System & Data

Quality and Safety Reporting System (QSRS) is a voluntary reporting system for staff to report any event that is not expected as part of the routine care of the patient or the day to day operation of the hospital. All CHCO staff members have access to the QSRS system. It is the responsibility of all staff to complete a QSRS when appropriate.
