
Our Mission

- **The CU Anschutz Office of Access and Engagement** serves as a vital bridge connecting people, resources and opportunities — both on campus and throughout the broader community. By fostering collaboration, access and trust, the program creates spaces and meaningful partnerships where students, faculty, staff and community members can thrive locally, regionally and statewide.
- We proudly serve more than 1,000 students through the **Educational Outreach and Career Pathway Initiative STEM programs**, helping to expand access to education, mentorship and career opportunities that prepare the next generation of leaders in science, technology, engineering and mathematics.
- **CU Anschutz Dental Medicine** sees more than 100,000 patient visits in low-cost dental clinics.
- **DAWN Health**, created by CU Anschutz School of Medicine students, provides free basic healthcare to underserved Aurora residents.


