Education for Family Caregivers of People with Dementia due to Parkinson's Disease or Lewy Bodies

National NIH-funded study testing an educational program for family caregivers of people What with Parkinson's Disease Dementia or Lewy Body Dementia. Family caregivers will gain weekly educational guidance though a 12-week curriculum with short readings, resources, and activities. All participation is virtual; there are NO in-person visits. Caregivers fill out surveys and assessments at baseline, and every two weeks for nine months. Who Family caregivers of a loved one with Parkinson's Disease Dementia, Parkinson's Disease with visual hallucinations, or Lewy Body Dementia with less than three years' experience as a caregiver. Length Once a week for 12 weeks: one-hour period to engage in educational activities. For nine months: Assessments and surveys every two weeks Your loved one with Parkinson's Disease or Lewy Body Dementia must have cognitive Criteria symptoms or hallucinations for less than three years. You must be living with or spending at least 10 hours/week caregiving now. • You must live in the US, have a phone and internet, and be comfortable speaking and reading English.
