



## Education for Family Caregivers of People with Dementia due to Parkinson’s Disease or Lewy Bodies

<b>What</b>	<p>National NIH-funded study testing an educational program for family caregivers of people with Parkinson’s Disease Dementia or Lewy Body Dementia.</p> <p>Family caregivers will gain weekly educational guidance through a 12-week curriculum with short readings, resources, and activities.</p> <p><b>All participation is virtual; there are NO in-person visits.</b> Caregivers fill out surveys and assessments at baseline, and every two weeks for nine months.</p>
<b>Who</b>	<p>Family caregivers of a loved one with Parkinson’s Disease Dementia, Parkinson’s Disease with visual hallucinations, or Lewy Body Dementia with less than <b>three</b> years’ experience as a caregiver.</p>
<b>Length</b>	<p><b>Once a week for 12 weeks:</b> one-hour period to engage in educational activities.</p> <p><b>For nine months:</b> Assessments and surveys every two weeks</p>
<b>Criteria</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Your loved one with Parkinson’s Disease or Lewy Body Dementia must have cognitive symptoms or hallucinations for <b>less than three years</b>.</li> <li>• You must be <b>living with</b> or spending at least <b>10 hours/week</b> caregiving now.</li> <li>• You must live in the US, have a phone and internet, and be comfortable speaking and reading English.</li> </ul>
<b>Gratitude</b>	<p>Up to \$275 for completing assessments throughout the study.</p>
