

Alzheimer's Clinical Trial



Do you know someone with Alzheimer's disease?

They may be eligible for a clinical trial for an investigational drug for the treatment of mild-to-moderate Alzheimer's disease. Participants will be asked to participate in weekly visits for 24 weeks, as well as screening and follow-up visits.

In order to qualify you must:

- be between 60-85 years old
- meet criteria for mild-to-moderate Alzheimer's disease
- complete PET scans (or optional lumbar punctures) before and after study completion and receive weekly blood draws
- have a study partner willing to give daily injections after training

Location

After initial screenings at the CU Anschutz campus in Aurora, CO, participants will be able to have weekly home nursing visits. Occasional visits to campus during the study will be required for procedures that cannot be done at home.

Participants will receive:

- study related care and medication at no cost
- stipend to defray some costs of participation
