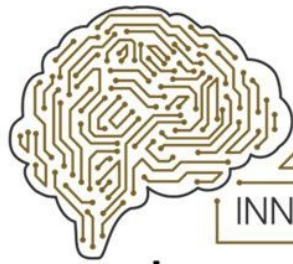

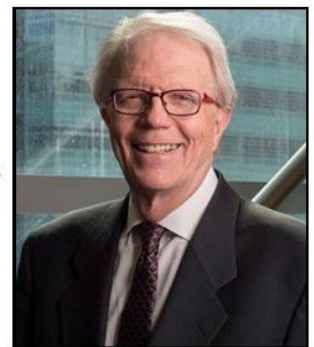

The Role of Inflammation in Alzheimer's Disease and the Aging Brain

Huntington Potter, PhD

Dr. Potter is Professor of Neurology, Director of the Alzheimer's Disease Program at the Linda Crnic Institute for Down Syndrome, and is Director of the CU Alzheimer's and Cognition Center at the University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Center. Previously, Dr. Potter studied, researched and taught for 30 years at Harvard University, then designed the Florida Alzheimer's Disease Research Center and the Johnnie B. Byrd Sr. Alzheimer's Center & Research Institute. He is currently expanding his discovery that Alzheimer's disease is mechanistically related to Down syndrome through the development of many cells with trisomy 21 and other aneuploidy. He is author of over 100 scientific articles, books and patents, has received numerous awards, and is a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science & the National Academy of Inventors.
