

SOM Rules/Promotions Changes in a nutshell:

This fact sheet provides a quick resource to understand and navigate the proposed changes to the University of Colorado School of Medicine promotions process:

- The Regular Faculty Series will be renamed "Tenured and Tenure-Elligible Track"— this avoids implying other tracks are irregular. Faculty employed by affiliates are still welcome in this track.
- The time-clock has been removed from the Clinical Practice and Research Professor Tracks with the addition of ranks of Instructor, Senior Instructor, and Assistant Professor.
- A single cover letter replaces four domain-specific portfolios.
- A single Personalized Promotions Matrix will replace four domain-specific matrices.
 It will reference pages in the dossier where information can be found—no more free text or cut-and-paste.
- Supplemental materials are required only for area(s) of Excellence (plus teaching evaluations for all).
- A CV Abstract will only be accepted in Tenure applications.
- Promotion criteria will not change, though wording is condensed for clarity.
