DEAN'S UPDATES

Dean Reilly announced that David DiGregorio, PhD, started as chair of the Department of Physiology and Biophysics on January 1.

A. Faculty Senate Updates:

Summary of the December meeting by Patrick Henn, MD, Faculty Senate President-Elect, and Assistant Professor of Pathology:

- After reviewing previous surveys, the Faculty Senate sent out a new survey to identify topics of interest, which resulted in identifying many topics for future meetings.
- Tyler Anstett, DO, provided updates from the Curriculum Steering Committee regarding to a program to guide medical students with their professional development.
- Shared workspaces and the need for expansion were discussed. Currently there are more than 500 faculty members that are part of the shared work environment with approximately 127 who are on the waitlist.
- To learn about other departments and foster future collaborations, a new initiative has been implemented this year to invite senators to present about their departments.
- Michael Clay, MD, from the department of Pathology gave a brief overview of the department.

Veterans Affairs Eastern Colorado Healthcare System

- The Deputy Chief of Staff of Inpatient, Sara Ashraf, MD, has started.
