APPROVAL OF MINUTES

The June 20, 2023, meeting minutes were unanimously approved.

DEAN'S UPDATES

The U.S. Supreme Court handed down a decision in June that limits consideration of race as a factor in admissions to institutions of higher education. Our commitment to recruiting a diverse class staff and faculty has not changed. We will do what we need to do to ensure our processes comply with the decision.

The 2027 class of medical students will be arriving in about a week. We have 184 students coming out of an applicant pool of over 9800 applications--43% men and 57% women. 42% are in-state residents and 58% come from outside of Colorado. 22 of those students, which is 12% of the class, are from the lowest socioeconomic status, meaning that they are likely the first person in their family to attend college.

Friday was the deadline for letters of intent for the Anschutz Acceleration Initiative research competition--we had more than 160 letters submitted.

Our new graduate students arrive in about two weeks. Angie Ribera, PhD, associate dean of research education, is piloting a new onboarding program to maximize student success. The class is much more diverse class than historically has been.

UCHealth University of Colorado Hospital hosted a grand-opening event for the Anschutz Inpatient Pavilion 3 in June. The new tower will include 10 operating rooms and 215 inpatient beds, including a 40-bed behavioral health unit. The tower is expected to be at full capacity in 2024.
