Questions on the Shared Care Support Plan:

1. Open SPLIT
2. Go to practice records
3. Search for your practice in the search box
4. Enter **Overall Mission and Vision** – practice specific
5. Enter **Practice Quality Improvement Infrastructure** – How and when do you get your improvement work done? Include things like regular

QI team meetings, huddles, leadership meetings or other times and ways your practice organizes improvement work.

6. Click on ISP project for additional project specific questions:
 - a. Motivation and Goals – What does the practice hope to gain from participating in the ISP Project or other programs?
 - b. Project Requirements: Data, Deliverables & other required activities – List the critical data, deliverables and other activities that are required for this project. Consider including quality measures, other data to report, meetings and conference. Consider including significant deadlines or due dates.
 - c. Hopes and Dreams – How do you imagine your practice functioning differently at the end of your engagement in the program you are participating in (i.e. what is your ideal state)?
 - d. Intervention Plan – Describe the way this project's support team will approach working in the practice.
7. Support Team – Will display after all questions are answered.
8. No need to save or submit – it will automatically save. This is an active document – anything you add or delete will be there or not be there the next time. This document can be accessed and edited by anyone working within SPLIT with that practice. We encourage you to enter a date and your name or initials when updating.
