Incentives and Support for MOUD

Practices with at least one provider with, or committed to getting, the X waiver, that have not prescribed MOUD to more than 4 patients in the last three months are eligible. ISM will help increase access to MOUD and give the providers and the team the confidence to offer MOUD to appropriate patients. MAT Team Training

For practices with at least one provider with, or committed to getting, their DEA x-waiver, the practice team training will equip all staff members with the expertise and tools to support a successful MAT program within a clinic. Practices will be compensated \$1,250 for completion of the project.
