

Value Based Payment Mentorship Program for Practices

Value based payment (VBP) programs allow health care providers to be paid for the quality, rather than the quantity, of care they provide.

Various entities in Colorado and nationwide have VBP programs, including the Regional Accountable Entities (RAEs), Medicare Accountable Care Organizations (ACOs), Making Care Primary, and commercial insurers.

Sometimes practices find these programs to be complex. We're here to help! The Value Based Payment Mentorship Program connects practices with experienced VBP mentors who will provide guidance to help your practice succeed in delivering value based care.

Mentors will work directly with practices to explore key VBP topics, offering support in practice discussions and attending meetings with practice teams as needed.

Mentors will be introduced by an administrator or provider champion and will assist practices in addressing a range of critical topics, including:

- ▶ A comprehensive understanding of existing Alternative Payment Models
- ▶ Tools and strategies to help practices assess and use prospective payment options
- ▶ Preparation to recruit and support practices for Making Care Primary
- ▶ Approaches to restructuring staff and resources to succeed in VBP
- ▶ Strategies to increase practice revenue, including tactics for improving attribution and maximizing shared savings
