It is with great pleasure that I write this letter to nominate Dr. Tyler Anstett as Outstanding Role Model. Dr. Anstett consistently personifies clinical excellence. He demonstrates the skills and knowledge needed to be an exemplary physician and has patiently overseen my professional development in the clinical setting.
