

<b>Policy Title</b>	Transfer Student Policy
<b>Policy Intent</b>	
This policy seeks to codify existing practices regarding the admission of transfer students to the University of Colorado School of Medicine.	
<b>Policy Definitions</b>	
LCME is defined as the Liaison Committee on Medical Education, and is the accrediting body for schools of medicine in the U.S.A. and Canada.	
<b>Policy</b>	
<p>The University of Colorado School of Medicine accepts transfer students from another LCME accredited medical school in rare circumstances, and only after basic science training is completed, and prior to their clerkship training.</p> <p>Each transfer student admitted into the medical school with a passing USMLE Step 1 score must have their academic history and credentials from their previous LCME accredited medical school reviewed and approved by the Admissions Committee prior to being accepted into the medical school.</p>
