The University of Colorado School of Medicine accepts transfer students from another LCME			
accredited medical school in rare circumstances, and only after basic science training is			
completed, and prior to their clerkship training.			
Each transfer student admitted into the medical school with a passing USMLE Step 1 score must			
have their academic history and credentials from their previous LCME accredited medical school			
reviewed and approved by the Admissions Committee prior to being accepted into the medical			
school.
