Assess the Learner

Quickly assess learner needs and goals to tailor teaching effectively.

2

Use Tiered Questioning

Ask learners questions matched to their level of training and responsibilities to keep everyone engaged.

Leverage Layered Learning

Engage more senior learners in teaching while you supervise and fill learning gaps.

4

Combine Group and Targeted Teaching

Share a core teaching point with everyone, then tailor follow-up teaching by level.

5

Align Roles with Learner Level

Assign responsibilities that match learner level to promote growth and autonomy.
