

VILLAGE CLINIC VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

Village Clinic: The Village Clinic offers COVID-19 and FLU vaccinations at no cost to the surrounding community. Currently, the clinic runs the second and fourth Tuesday of every month in the evening hours from 4:30pm-7:00pm. On average, the clinic vaccinates between 80 and 100 individuals on clinic days. With funding through Arapahoe county, residents of Arapahoe county may be eligible to receive a \$100 incentive for each vaccination received. VEC also partners with outside organizations to bring the incentive into the Arapahoe county community. To date, VEC with the support of other community organizations have given more than 7,207 vaccinations to the community.

FAQ ON VOLUNTEERING AT THE CLINIC

What dress attire is appropriate?

We ask that volunteers wear comfortable clothing and casual dress attire.

What can I expect to do during my shift at the clinic?

The volunteers assist with registration of community members, guiding the flow of traffic, setting up chairs, tables and resource stations and tearing down at the end of the clinic. For volunteers who speak multiple languages, bilingual volunteers may assist the pharmacists with interpretation.

Are minors allowed to volunteer at the clinic?

We ask that volunteers at the clinic be at least 16 years of age.

What population is served at the clinic?

The clinic is open to the public regardless of area of residence. However, most of the individuals served at the clinic come from the surrounding areas of Adams, Arapahoe and Denver counties with a large number being uninsured.
