Meet the Psychiatry Residents

Psychiatry residents are involved in telepsychiatry across the department of family medicine. Alongside their attending psychiatrists, the residents provide quality psychiatric services via secured video chat to assess and clarify psychiatric conditions and provide appropriate recommendations. This allows family medicine patients to receive psychiatric services without the long wait that often comes with a psychiatry referral. Telepsychiatry is a valuable aspect of integrated family medicine and behavioral health services.

Westminster Metabolic Clinic

- The Westminster Family Medicine clinic is developing a multidisciplinary metabolic clinic, UCHealth PATHWEIGH, designed for patients with obesity and related issues. The integrated treatment team includes: primary care provider, Erik Seth Kramer, DO, MPH, endocrinologist, Leigh Perreault, MD, and the behavioral health team, Lauren Tolle, PhD and Noy Phimphasone-Brady, PhD.
- Patients who would benefit from weight loss treatment are referred and the initial visit will
 assess history of weight gain and attempts to lose, nutrition, activity, goals for weight loss,
 and related psychosocial concerns. With their treatment team, patients develop an
 individualized treatment plan aligned with their weight loss goals and values. We plan to
 gather data on both patients' success in a number of physical health and psychosocial
 outcomes, and cost-effectiveness outcomes.
- After developing, expanding, and evaluating this initiative at Westminster Family Medicine, we
 propose long-term plans to build an optional EPIC disease management workflow and
 optimization platform. This could allow the clinic to ultimately be scaled up to the UCHealth
 system and hopefully beyond. Please contact any member of the treatment team for more
