Kudos to DFM's Dr. Mark Deutchman for his tireless work on newly passed legislation in Colorado that will support quality healthcare in rural parts of our state.

SB 172 provides funding for rural community partner programs to tap into a network of training and support that will enable them to design and implement a primary care workforce training and recruitment plan based on their unique

needs.

This goes far beyond just physicians to include other vital health professions including nursing and dentistry.
