Patients are saying some nice things about our DFM clinicians.

Suzanne Stamm (Boulder):

"Dr. Stamm, whom I saw as Dr. Lewis, my PCP, was unavailable on the schedule needed. (I had just been discharged to home from a stroke (or stroke-like symptoms) hospitalization. Dr. Stamm listened carefully, then engaged in a discussion of blood pressure, it's importance in monitoring health, and calibrated my home blood pressure monitor against the clinic equipment. A careful and obviously caring approach, making sure I understood the hospital instructions about my prescribed medications, and the reasons therefor. We discussed next steps; Dr. Stamm laid out a home blood pressure monitoring and reporting schedule for me to follow. Dr. Stamm messaged both Dr. Lewis, my PCP, and Dr. Abrahams, my cardiologist, to bring them into the plan for deciding on what medications I would take daily, and WHY. This last step is most important to comment on; she made sure I understood WHY the plan was set up the way it was. Cannot overemphasise how much this means to a patient ! In more than 30 years as a patient at Boulder Family Medicine, this is a commendable example of the excellent care provided by the doctors, nurses and staff at Boulder Family Medicine. I am a cancer survivor, a stroke survivor (2), and a most grateful patient."

He is clearly knowledgeable and trustworthy as a provider— considering both evidence-based medicine and patient preference when choosing a plan of action.
