

## Family Medicine in Practice: Dr. Stephanie Gold



I've been fortunate to find a position that allows me to incorporate all of my interests as a family doctor. I practice primary care a couple days a week at the Denver Health Lowry Family Health Center, where we take care of a large underserved and immigrant and refugee patient population. In a typical morning in clinic I might see a mix of visits for chronic disease management, prenatal care, well child care, family planning, urgent/acute concerns, and physicals. I attend on our inpatient medicine teams a few weeks out of the year and have been delivering babies as well (though currently phasing out of this due to slightly dropping my overall time and having to cut back on something – a tough decision!). I enjoy establishing relationships with patients and following them over time, taking care of whole families, and seeing patients in a variety of settings.

Outside of clinical practice, I work at the Farley Health Policy Center on the CU campus. The Farley Center focuses on integration of behavioral health and social policy to improve health and well being. I'm particularly interested in payment reform for primary care and am a member of the state Primary Care Payment Reform Collaborative. I also have gotten involved in state policy through my role as a board member of the Colorado Academy of Family Physicians.
