
Primary Care Response: COVID-19

This report was created from the data received from 38 responses to the SNOCAP/PIPCO survey between April 3-13, 2020



28 respondents are part of a hospital system or clinical network...


10 respondents are not.

Testing availability remains low. Only 24% of respondents reported having adequate availability for testing.

The majority (66%) have recommended 10 or fewer patients for testing.




