- ◇ \$300/month housing/travel stipend in addition to excellent benefits through CU School of Medicine

THE COMMUNITY

- ◇ Fort Morgan is one of the most diverse communities in Colorado with a population of 11,439 people
 - Hispanic/Latinx (53%), White (38%), East African, West African
 - 31% speak a language other than English at home
- ◇ Year-round community, music and cultural events
- ◇ Access to outdoor activities and sports: walking/running trails, biking, water sports, fishing, local sports leagues
- ◇ Plentiful dining options, local winery, and brewery (coming 2024)

CLINIC

Salud Family Health Center

- ◇ Part of the Salud Family Health regional healthcare system that includes 14 Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) PCMH clinics and a mobile unit throughout northeastern Colorado designed to provide healthcare to migrant and refugee populations.
- ◇ Salud is committed to providing care to all community members regardless of finances.
- ◇ Provides medical, dental, pharmacy, and behavioral health services.
- ◇ 5 minute drive between clinic and the hospital.

HOSPITAL

St. Elizabeth Hospital

- ◇ 50 bed acute-care hospital serving a two-county area of 35,000 people for over 70 years.
- ◇ Features a Level III Trauma Center, 24-hour Emergency Room, 6 bed ICU and an updated Birthing Center with c-section suite.
- ◇ Residents work with surgically-trained Family Medicine Obstetricians in addition to physicians in Family Medicine, Internal Medicine, Pediatrics, General Surgery, Orthopedic Surgery, and Emergency Medicine.
