Dear Training Grant Faculty and Cancer Biology trainees,

We are pleased to announce that T32CA190216-09, "Training Program in Cancer Biology", is now accepting applications for pre-doc trainees. There are no postdoctoral training slots available for the upcoming funding cycle.

This grant (including associated Cancer Center funds) will provide funds (stipends, benefits and tuition) for up to three new predocs this award year. Only predoctoral students in the Cancer Biology PhD program are eligible to apply for the predoc slots. Preference will be given to rising 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> year students. All trainees will be required to focus directly on cancer related research for their projects. Trainees must be supported by a faculty mentor with R01 (or equivalent) funding for a cancer-related project and is appointed to the T32 training faculty.

To apply for a training slot, applicants should submit their compiled proposal by June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025. Applications will be reviewed by the Recruitment Committee and awardees notified in the third week in July. Trainees will be appointed to the T32 August 1, 2025.

Applicants must be US citizens or have a green card.

The following should be included in your application:

- 1. Required TPCB T32 Cover Sheet. Please answer all questions.
- 2. A one page Specific Aims plan that describes your proposed research project
- 3. A one page Training Plan that describes the proposed career development of the trainee.
- 4. Mentor NIH biosketch
- 5. Trainee NIH biosketch
- 6. Two letters of recommendation. One of these letters must be from your mentor.
- 7. Transcripts (undergraduate and graduate- can be "unofficial")

Please note that trainees will be required to apply for additional extramural funding (e.g., individual F-award or equivalent) during their first year of T32 support.

The application should be compiled into a single pdf and submitted via Smartsheets found at the following link <u>TPCB Year 09 Trainee Application Form</u>. Applications are due no later than June 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025 at 5pm. More information can be found at Training Program in Cancer Biology T32.
