Dear Training Grant Faculty and Cancer Biology trainees,

We are pleased to announce that T32CA190216-10, "Training Program in Cancer Biology", is now accepting applications for pre- and post-doc trainees. This grant (including associated Cancer Center funds) will provide funds (stipends, benefits, travel and tuition) for both predoctoral students and postdoctoral fellows.

**T32 Pre-doctoral appointments (up to 2 T32 awards, and 1 T32-associated award):**

Only predoctoral students in the Cancer Biology PhD program are eligible to apply for the predoc slots. Preference will be given to rising 3rd and 4th year students. All trainees will be required to focus directly on cancer related research for their projects. Trainees must be supported by a faculty mentor with R01 (or equivalent) funding for a cancer-related project and is appointed to the T32 training faculty. **T32 Post-doctoral appointments (up to 3 awards)**

Postdoctoral trainees with a PhD or MD, and two years or less of training are eligible. All trainees will be required to focus directly on cancer related research for their projects. Trainees must be supported by a faculty mentor with R01 (or equivalent) funding for a cancer-related project and is appointed to the T32 training faculty. [CLICK HERE](#) for a list of participating faculty. Only trainees located on the Anschutz Medical Campus are eligible.

**Trainee application process:**

To apply for a training slot, applicants should submit their compiled proposal by **June 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026** at 5:00 p.m. via Smartsheets found at the following link [TPCB Yr 10 Trainee Application Form](#). Applications will be reviewed by the Recruitment Committee and awardees notified in the third week in July. Trainees will be appointed to the T32 August 1, 2026.

**Applicants must be US citizens or have a green card for T32 awards. T32-associated pre-doctoral awards are available with no requirement for US citizenship. T32-associated training and expectations will be identical to T32 awards.**

The following should be included in your application and compiled into one pdf:

1. Required TPCB T32 Cover Sheet. Please answer all questions.
2. A one page Specific Aims plan that describes your proposed research project
3. A one page Training Plan that describes the proposed career development of the trainee.
4. Mentor NIH biosketch
5. Trainee NIH biosketch
6. Two letters of recommendation. One of these letters must be from your mentor.
7. Transcripts (undergraduate and graduate- can be "unofficial")

Please note that trainees will be required to apply for additional extramural funding (e.g., individual F-award or equivalent) during their first year of T32 support.
