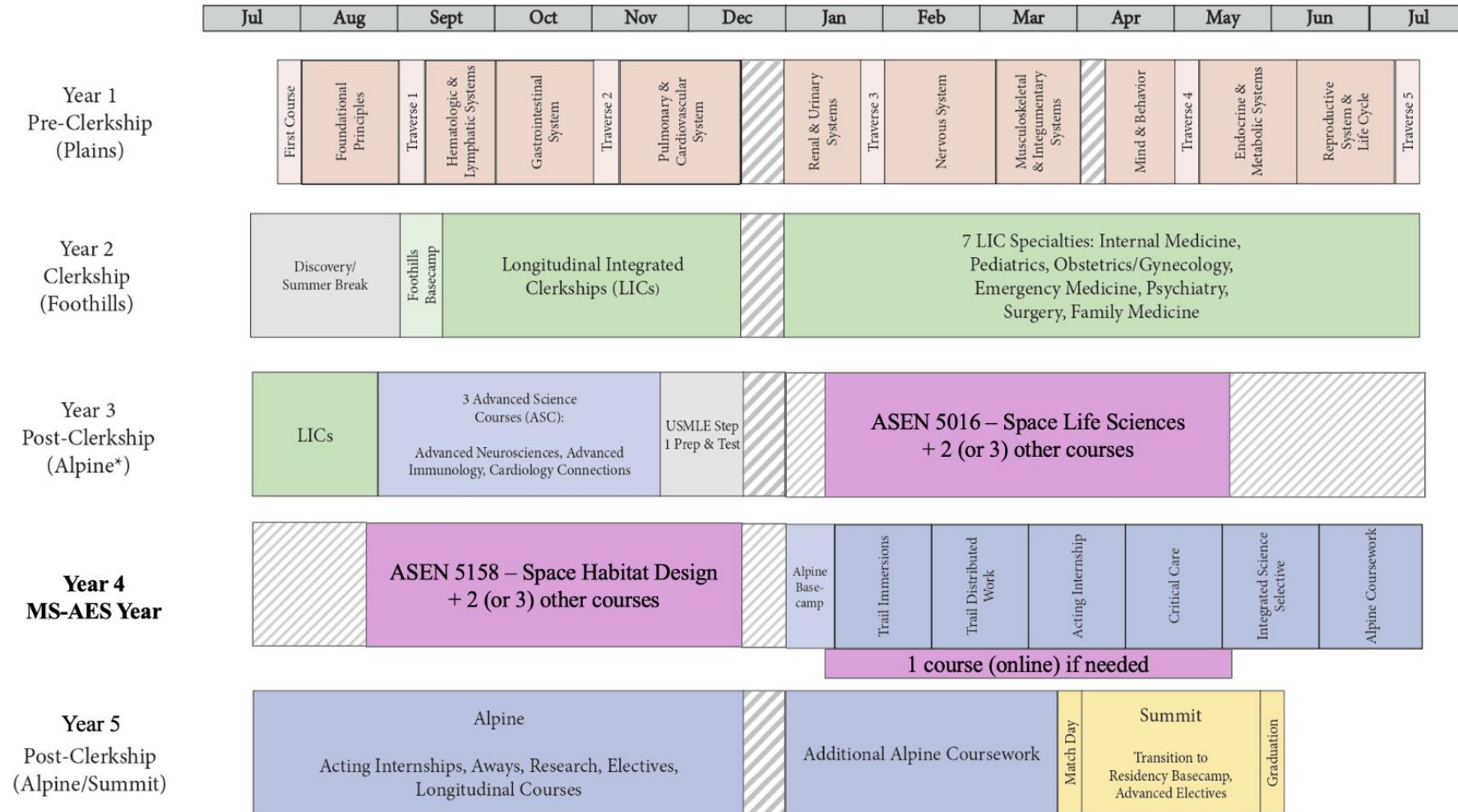


Trek Curriculum Map

- The three pillars of the Trek Curriculum - **Medical Sciences**, **Clinical Sciences**, and **Health Systems Science** - are incorporated through all phases of the curriculum.
- Five **Traverse** weeks occur throughout the Plains year and consist of comprehensive assessments and longitudinal activities supporting students' professional growth and development.
- The **Basecamp** course is a longitudinal curriculum that spans the clinical years of medical school, helping students to develop and advance relevant knowledge and skills required for the next stage of their clinical training.
- The **Trail Immersion** sessions prepare students to be change agents in chosen areas of concentration that play to their strengths.
- Curriculum is delivered at the Anschutz Medical Campus, Fort Collins Regional campus, and clerkship sites throughout the state.
