

Department of Medicine Research and Equity in Academic Medicine (DREAM) Program

PROGRAM APPLICATION

The DREAM Program provides the opportunity for emerging University of Colorado second-year medical school students to conduct a research project of their own choosing and with a mentor of their own choosing during the summer before their second year of medical school. The DREAM Program runs for 8 weeks—typically June to August (can be flexible - determined with the research mentor)—for up to 10 CU medical students who meet the broad definition of diversity, adopted by the CU School of Medicine which includes race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability, religion, political beliefs and socioeconomic status, as well as life experiences, record of service and employment, and other talents and personal attributes that can enhance our scholarly, clinical care and learning environment. To make this program accessible to all students, the Department of Medicine provides a stipend of \$3,000 for the program. Final deadline to apply for the summer is April 1 of the year before you begin.
