	MedHub Package #3: Medicare (PECOS) and Colorado Medicaid Enrollment	June 23 rd	June 24 th	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- This package has a very quick turnaround - 24 hours.- You will need to upload proof of submission to MedHub for each application,.
