Greetings.

I hope you, your family, and your friends are doing well. I have several important developments I want to share with you.

Clinical: The IHME website (<http://www.healthdata.org/covid/updates>) predicts that Colorado will reach its peak number of Covid cases by April 17th. Currently, at UCH, Hospital Medicine has 5 Covid teams, MICU has 4 surge-ICU teams that are led by pulmonary, anesthesiology, and surgery, and ID has 5 inpatient services. The below Covid census was taken at midnight and by 8AM this morning there are 43 COVID ICU patients at UCH. Attached also is a set of instructions prepared by Brian Montague to access the Covid-19 dashboard through EPIC.

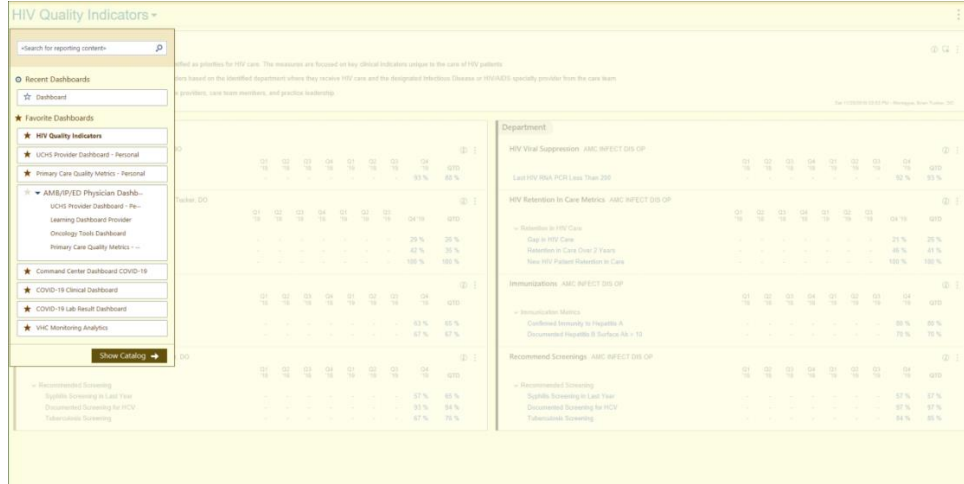

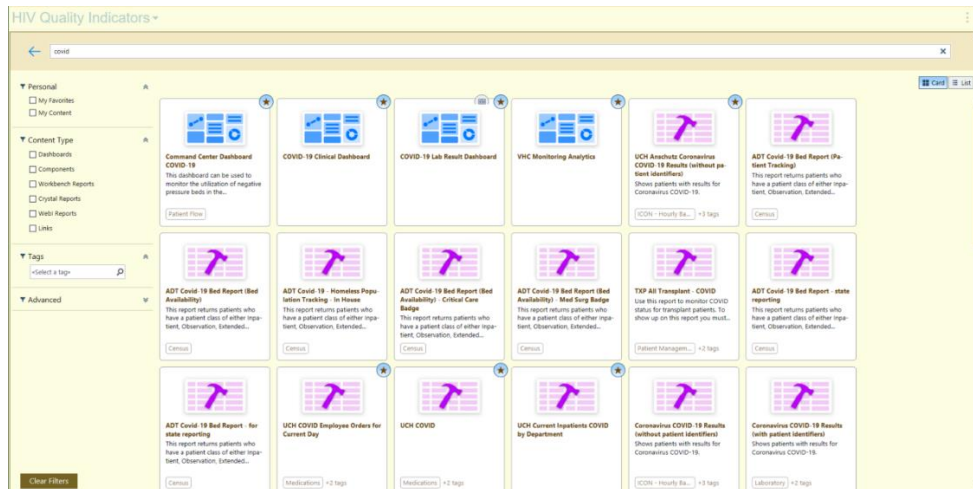
