Subject: DOM survey to identify inpatient providers

Greetings.

My apologies for all of these emails, however, our challenges change daily. Due to the potential need for more inpatient teams, we would like to know which DOM faculty (AMC, VAMC, NJH, and DH) would be able to cover inpatient medicine teams at UCH.

- You do not need to be board certified in internal medicine to attend during this emergency.
- You would not be expected to care for any suspected or diagnosed COVID-19 patients as we already have dedicated hospitalist teams for that role.

Please let us know if you would be available to staff covered teams as a supervising attending (working with trainees who are superbly efficient and skilled in inpatient medicine) and/or working by yourself to provide direct patient care or helping to provide cross-cover at night. The inpatient teams have developed robust tiered back up plans and we will only utilize this mechanism for back up if our other backup systems have been fully utilized. We may also have to mobilize providers who don't volunteer if the need exceeds our pool of providers. National organizations such as ACP, SGIM, SHM are working together to develop training materials for subspecialists and outpatient docs to familiarize themselves with common hospital scenarios in the event our hospitals become overloaded and we have a shortage of care providers in these settings.
