### **Missed Deadline Policy:**

The formal policy on consequences for failure to meet program requirements (for example unexcused WES absences, missing deadlines for module completion and TB testing, etc.) is as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> miss** You will receive an email noting the missed deadline and a reminder about the various deadlines in residency.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> miss** Email notice. You will be offered the opportunity to speak with a CMR and/or your APD.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> miss** Email notice. You are required to meet with a CMR to discuss residency requirements
- 4<sup>th</sup> miss** Email notice. You are required to meet with your APD. Resident advised they will be brought to Clinical Competency Committee for review for ACGME Milestone PROF-2 (“Accepts responsibility and follows through on tasks.”).
- 5<sup>th</sup> miss** Email Notice. Meeting with Program Director. Resident advised they will be brought to Clinical Competency Committee for review for Milestone PROF-2. Focused Review option from PD for PROF-2 (not a permanent part of training file).
- 6<sup>th</sup> miss** Email notice. Meet with APD, PD, and possibly GME. Resident advised they will be brought to Clinical Competency Committee for review for Milestone PROF-2. Focused review initiated with PD option of Probation for PROF-2 (permanent part of training file).
