Specific Goals:

1. Acquire basic core knowledge of clinical manifestations, clinical presentations, pathophysiology, and management of orthopaedic diseases or system diseases with orthopaedic manifestations. **MK, PC*
2. Develop the clinical skill of data collection including history taking, physical examination, and the appropriate request of laboratory and imaging studies *ISC, PC, PBLI, SBP*
3. The performance and/or interpretation of diagnostic tests and therapeutic procedures common in the practice of orthopaedic medicine. *MK, PBLI*
4. Review the typical radiographic features of common orthopaedic diseases. *MK, PBLI, PC*
5. Recognize the need for appropriate orthopaedics consultation. *PC, MK, P*

 - b. Arthritis
 - c. Rotator cuff disease
2. Develop Clinical and Technical Skills: *ISC, PC, P*

 - b. Physical examination including the structure and function of axial and peripheral joints, periarticular structures, and peripheral nerves, and muscles.
 - c. Arthrocentesis and interpretation of synovial fluid analysis.
