General **Information**

Neurosurgery in the Rockies is an intimate gathering hosted by the Department of Neurosurgery at the University of Colorado School of Medicine and the Colorado Neurosurgical Society. This conference is designed for neurosurgeons, residents, and allied health professionals who have an interest in the clinical neurosciences. The first two days of the conference will be subspecialty focused in the area of Spine surgery and the final two days will include general neurosurgery topics relevant to private practice and academic neurosurgery. Special topic lectures will be given by internationally renowned visiting and local faculty.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of this activity, participants should be able to:

1. Learn the nuance and scientific basis of the management of concussion in professional and amateur athletics.
2. Translate the current international literature related to severe traumatic brain injury into clinical practice pertinent to one's own practice environment.
3. Gain an improved understanding of the literature and practice of spinal cord injury
4. Gain an improved understanding of the literature and practice of head and spine trauma including concussion.
5. Review current standards of care relevant to private practice neurosurgery including vascular, stroke, tumor, pediatric, functional, and general neurosurgery.
