









Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Perform hand hygiene prior to and after donning ANY mask. It is important to NOT touch the outside of the facemask with your hands.
If you touch or adjust your facemask, you must immediately perform hand hygiene.

<div>Extended use and reuse:</div> <p>Disposable gowns to be prioritized for aerosol-generating procedures, care activities where splashes and sprays or contact with body fluids are anticipated, and patients in contact isolation precautions.</p> <div>Recommended for reuse</div> <p>by multiple HCWs for low- or moderate-risk scenarios and for patients on contact precautions for MRSA, VRE or MDRO.</p> <div>Low-risk scenarios:</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Basic patient care or cover gown for visitors. <div>Moderate-risk scenarios:</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Performing blood draws, suturing, establishing IV access, wound/ostomy care.Store in a manner to prevent contamination close to the patient door in the patient room. <div>Not recommended for reuse</div> <p>if soiled or damaged or if used in high risk scenarios:</p> <div>High-risk scenarios:</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Precautions for suspected or confirmed COVID-19Invasive procedures or surgeryLengthy, fluid intense proceduresTrauma casesSpecial contact precautionsPrecautions for CRE <div>Discard after use.</div>	<div>Extended use and reuse:</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none">1 per staff member per shift (can use with multiple patients)Store in paper bag with employee name and date when not in usePlace in reprocessing bin at end of shiftDiscard if contaminated with body fluids or compromised (damaged/difficult to breathe through).	<div>Extended use and reuse:</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none">1 per staff member per shift if clinically indicated (can use with multiple patients).Store in paper bag with employee name and date when not in use.Place in collection bin at end of shift.Discard if contaminated with body fluids or compromised (damaged/ difficult to breathe through).Prioritize for procedures likely to generate respiratory aerosols (bronch, intubation, sputum induction, nebulizer treatment).	<div>Extended use and reuse:</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Use for multiple HCW.Clean and disinfect hood and PAPR device after each use.Discard hood if torn, visibly soiled or damaged.	<div>Extended use and reuse:</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Use for multiple HCW.Clean and disinfect after each use.Discard if damaged. <div>Personal eyeglasses do not provide protection.</div>
	<div>When caring for suspected or confirmed COVID-19 patients NOT requiring aerosol generating procedures:</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Wear surgical/procedural mask across all patient encounters.DO NOT store and reuse.Place in bin for reprocessing at <u>each break</u> and at end of day.Obtain new mask.	<div>When caring for suspected or confirmed COVID-19 patients requiring aerosol generating procedures:</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Limit personnel in room.Wear N95 for procedure/treatment.DO NOT store and reuse.Place in reprocessing bin after procedure/treatment.	<div>Half Facepiece Reusable Respirator</div> <div></div>	<div>Facemasks</div> <div></div>
	<div>Patient use: (e.g. for transport)</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Provide 1 over the course of hospitalization.Store in paper bag in patient room with patient name and date when not in use.Discard when no longer needed.	<div></div>	<div>Extended use and reuse:</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><u>Single</u> HCW only.Perform negative/positive check prior to use.Clean and disinfect device after each use (avoid moistening filters).Wipe the plastic where it comes into contact with skin with an alcohol wipe.	<div>Extended use and reuse:</div> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Use for multiple HCW.Clean and disinfect after each use.Place in reprocessing bin at end of shift.Discard if torn or damaged. <div>Face Mask w/ Shield is <u>single user</u> only (can use with multiple patients).</div>
