Subglottic stenosis/Critical airway

Workup: ** if patient is stable

- -CT neck without contrast with fine cuts (larynx/trachea protocol)
- -Spirometry (needs to include Peak Inspiratory Flow)

At bedside:

- -5-0ETT, 6-0 ETT- both cuffed and uncuffed endotracheal tubes
- -Bougie
- -Tracheostomy set with scalpel
- -Acute airway sign
- -Tracheostomy tubes (4-0 cuffless and cuffed, 6-0 cuffless and cuffed)

Medications:

- -Continuous pulse ox
- -Humidified face tent, q4hr saline nebs, consider heliox
- -mucomist nebs q6hrs + bronchodilator
- -NPO
- -Hold anticoagulation if able
- -Notify ENT with change in WOB, desaturations, increased O2 requirement
