

We are proud to announce the **Notice of Award for the Colorado Nutrition Obesity Research Center (NORC, P30 DK048520)**.

The University of Colorado remains one of only 11 NIH-funded Nutrition Obesity Research Centers in the nation.

The Colorado NORC supports a robust and growing research base of 198 faculty and trainees across the Rocky Mountain region, with 28 external collaborators from 21 institutions nationwide.

Collectively, our 125 funded faculty represent an annual research portfolio of \$65 million (direct costs).

Key highlights relevant to our Department and Division:

- 39% of participants are Department of Medicine faculty
- 20% are Endocrinology Division faculty
- 13% are affiliated with the Anschutz Health and Wellness Center
- Additional representation from Cardiology, Geriatrics, CVP, Gastroenterology, Infectious Disease, Internal Medicine, Medical Oncology, Pulmonary, and Renal Divisions

Her presentation emphasized the importance of personalized care and the integration of molecular data in guiding treatment pathways for thyroid disease.








Community Highlight — Beta Cell Team Shines at ADA Tour de Cure!
