<u>Visitor Parking Lots</u> (\$1.00 per hour): Kiowa (4-hour maximum), Julesburg, or Georgetown



Stop 1: Education 2 South Building

- Location on interactive map
- Anschutz Medical Campus Bookstore (first floor)
- Physical Therapy Program Offices (3rd floor)
- Small group study rooms (1st and 2nd floors)

Stop 3: Boettcher Commons

- · Grassy area to the west of Education 2 North
- When weather permits, students check out volleyball nets/balls, corn hole and spike ball from Campus Student Services

Stop 5: Education 1 Building
