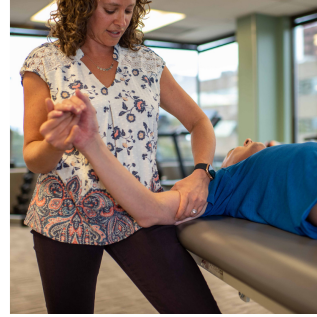




Job Description:
