Incorporate information from patient’s story into providing patient-centered care 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Students will discuss key information gleaned from the story to help better understand the patient's point of view. Students will also discuss ways in which they might respond to the patient with compassion and caring during future encounters. 2. Group will provide feedback and reflect on the technique used in allowing the patient to tell their story. (i.e. questions asked, verbal and nonverbal communication, etc.) 3.
