DPT PROGRAM EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP AND CURRICULUM INNOVATION

Musculoskeletal Track Leadership (DPT Program)

- Instituted an annual MSK track retreat to develop a shared mission, vision, and goals across MSK I-IV (10 credits).
- Led backward design of all MSK courses, including course outcomes and session-level objectives aligned to program competencies.
- Implemented standardized rubrics based on the evidence-based Clinical Reasoning Assessment Tool (CRAT) for formative and summative assessment across the MSK curriculum.
- Adapted and integrated the evidence-based Systematic Clinical Reasoning in Physical Therapy (SCRIPT) tool, used in residency and fellowship training, into entry-level MSK education as a unifying organizational and clinical reasoning framework.
- Redesigned summative assessments to emulate the national physical therapy examination (NPTE), including integration of video-based assessment items.
- Collaborated with the simulation assessment team to align program simulation rubrics with the CRAT and Competency Based Education in Physical Therapy (CBEPT) framework and competencies within the COMPASS curriculum.
- Integrated orthopaedic residents and fellows in training into MSK courses to provide near-peer mentoring and exposure to clinical teaching of beginner learners.
- Disseminated MSK curriculum innovations resulting in four peer-reviewed publications, six abstract presentations at national meetings, and multiple invited educational presentations focused on clinical reasoning and psychomotor skill development.

Section Director of Curriculum / Chair, Curriculum Committee

- Chair and Section Director for curriculum overseeing program-wide curricular planning, mapping, assessment alignment, and continuous quality improvement.
- Led curriculum mapping project in EXXAT to CAPTE domains, NPTE content, and CBEPT Domains of competence across residential and hybrid pathways.
- Guided development and implementation of programmatic assessment strategies, including integrated practical examinations (CAPE/PULSE) and progression-linked remediation.
- Led and co-led faculty development initiatives related to teaching, learning pedagogy, assessment (formative and summative), feedback, CBEPT and competencies, and NPTE task force initiatives.
- Coordinated curricular governance and task forces supporting hybrid/residential alignment, workload calibration, and student absence, remediation and progression policies.
- Used PT-GQ and internal assessment data to inform curriculum refinement and program improvement.

Lead, COMPASS Competency-Based DPT Curriculum

- Initiated (2024) and led development of COMPASS, a competency-based DPT curricular framework aligned with the national CBEPT framework, with full implementation in Summer 2027.
- Directed the update of program, faculty and student goals to align with CBEPT domains of competence.
- Directed the update of all curricular threads including ongoing mapping and assessment.
