### Tuition Rates

**Colorado Flat Rate Resident Tuition:** \$19,239 /annual

**Non-Resident Flat Rate Tuition:** \$41,656 /annual

Students' assessed non-resident tuition upon admission may apply for resident tuition the semester after residency is established. Most students are able to meet these requirements and be assessed resident tuition after the first year. Please review the requirements for establishing residency [here](#).

\*\*Tuition and fees are established by the Board of Regents, the governing body of the University of Colorado, and are subject to change at any time.

### Fees

- **Matriculation:** \$140.00 – one-time; 1<sup>st</sup> year
- **Academic Support Services Fee:** \$64.00 – each semester
- **Activity Fee:** \$20.00 - per year
- **Anschutz RTD College Pass Program:** \$53.35/semester – This student activity fee, approved by a student election in fall 2008, is required of all degree-seeking students at the Anschutz Medical Campus. It supports the RTD College Pass Program and covers contractual payments due to RTD and the cost of providing term decals and student badges. Revisions require student vote.
- **Study Abroad Fee:** \$400 - This fee funds the Office of Global Education's operational expenses and costs for administration of study abroad advising, risk management, registration, and records. This fee is charged only for the first term when there are consecutive terms abroad.
- **Health Insurance Plan A:** \$4,185.94 – All degree-seeking students enrolled in 1 or more credit hours at Anschutz Medical Campus are required to have health insurance. Students carrying their own insurance may request this fee be waived if their plan is considered comparable. This fee pays for a comprehensive insurance plan covering student injury and illness, known as Plan A (High Option). For more information, contact the Office of Student Health.
- **Health Insurance Plan B:** \$3612.00 - All degree-seeking students enrolled in 1 or more credit hours at Anschutz Medical Campus are required to have health insurance. Students carrying their own insurance may request this fee be waived if their plan is considered comparable. This fee pays for a high deductible insurance plan covering student injury and illness, known as Plan B (Low Option). For more information, contact the Office of Student Health.

### Other Expenses

- Books and equipment estimate (subject to change)
  - 1<sup>st</sup> year: \$3,100.00
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> year: \$1,200.00
- Academic travel:
  - 1<sup>st</sup> year: \$100.00
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> year: \$400.00
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> year: \$2,420.00
- Graduation expenses for composite photo sitting and regalia if desired by student. Approx. \$75-\$500 depending on choices made by student in the 3<sup>rd</sup> year, last semester.
- Students are responsible for travel, housing, and living expenses related to clinical education and are required to complete at least one 3<sup>rd</sup> year clinical rotation in a rural area. Clinical education costs are variable depending on number, location and length of clinical rotations.

### **Admissions Expenses – 2020-2021 Academic Year**

- Students offered admission to the program must submit at \$1,000.00 confirmation deposit to hold their place. This deposit will be applied to the first semester of the program.
- Students admitted into the program must submit \$65.00 for a criminal background check.
- Students admitted to the program are responsible for the costs of immunization requirements and tuberculosis screening approx. \$55.00 in the first semester
  - Additional clinical expenses may include fingerprinting, additional health screenings, immunizations, additional urine drug testing, repeated criminal background checks, or any other requirements of a specific site. This is dependent on the clinical site.
