

Help Us Improve Health Care Communication! Study for Adults with Down Syndrome

Are you an adult with Down syndrome establishing care with a new primary care provider? You may be eligible to participate in a research study to help improve communication between patients, supporters, and doctors.

What is the study about? We are studying how doctors, patients with Down syndrome, and their supporters talk to each other during clinic visits. The goal is to create a communication tool that makes these visits easier and more effective.

What will you do if you participate?

- Have your next primary care visit video and audio recorded (a small camera will be used; no extra people will be in the room).
- Complete short surveys (paper or electronic) about the visit.
- Participants will receive compensation for their time.

Who can join?

- Adults with Down syndrome
- Their family members or supporters who attend the medical visit
- Must be able to understand and speak English
- Must be planning a new visit with a primary care provider
